

# IN TALBOT COUNTY COURT,

SITTING AS A COURT OF CHANCERY,

May Term, 1827.

**O**RDERED by the Court that the sale of the Lands made to Samuel Mackey, by Matthew J. Higgins, Trustee for the sale of the Real Estate of Philip Mackey, deceased, in the cause of Philip Mackey, Executor of William Mackey, against Eleanor Ward, Thomas J. Mackey, Eliza Mackey, and others heirs of the said Philip Mackey, deceased, and reported to this Court by the said Trustee, be ratified and confirmed unless cause to the contrary be shown, on or before the second Monday in November, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty-seven; provided a copy of this order be inserted once in each of three successive weeks, in one of the newspapers published in Easton, Talbot county, before the tenth day of July, in the year aforesaid.

The Report of the Trustee states the amount of sale to be \$1970,10.
